THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1: In the present by-law, "public place" means any place where the public is expressly or implicitly invited.

ARTICLE 2: It is prohibited for anyone to be in a public place, street, park, or public square, on foot or in a public transit vehicle, bearing or carrying a knife, sword, machete or other similar object, without reasonable excuse.

For the purposes of the present article, self-defense does not constitute a reasonable excuse.

ARTICLE 3: Anyone contravening a provision of this by-law, tolerating or permitting such a contravention, commits an infraction and is liable to the following fine:

- for a first infraction: a minimum fine of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) and a maximum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) if the offender is a physical person or a maximum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000) if the offender is a moral person;
- for a repeated infraction: a minimum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) and a maximum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000) if the offender is a physical person or a maximum of FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,000) if the offender is a moral person.

ARTICLE 4: The present by-law comes into force according to law.
