**BY-LAW AMENDING BY-LAW NO. 2013-54
RELATING TO NUISANCES IN ORDER TO MODIFY
THE HOURS OF USE OF TOOLS LIKELY TO CAUSE
NOISE NUISANCES**

ADOPTION PROCEDURE

- WHEREAS pursuant to section 59 of the Municipal Powers Act (CQLR, c. C-47.1), the Town of Kirkland may adopt by-laws concerning nuisances;
- WHEREAS pursuant to section 356 of the Cities and Towns Act (CQLR, c. C-19), notice of motion of this by-law was given and a draft of this by-law was filed at the regular sitting of the Municipal Council held on July 5, 2021;
- WHEREAS copies of this by-law were made available to the public;
- WHEREAS the Preamble forms an integral part of this by-law;

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1 NOISE – MECHANICAL DEVICES

Chapter III of the by-law is amended by replacing Article 7.6 with the following:

- “7.6 Constitutes a nuisance and is prohibited to use or permit the use of a chainsaw, lawn mower, leaf blower, grass-trimmer, hedge trimmer, mechanical, electric or pneumatic tool or any similar tool:
- a) before 7 a.m. and after 9 p.m., Monday to Friday;
 - b) before 9 a.m. and after 6 p.m. on Saturdays;
 - c) before 10 a.m. and after 4 p.m., on Sundays and holidays.”

ARTICLE 2 COMING INTO FORCE

This by-law shall come into force in accordance with the law.
