## **BY-LAW NO: 2013-54-9**

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**BY-LAW AMENDING BY-LAW NO. 2013-54  
RELATING TO NUISANCES IN ORDER TO ADD  
ELEMENTS CAUSING NUISANCES**

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### **ADOPTION PROCEDURE**

Notice motion:	May 2, 2022
Filing of draft by-law:	May 2, 2022
Adoption of by-law:	June 13, 2022
Publication:	June 17, 2022
Coming into force:	June 17, 2022

- WHEREAS pursuant to section 59 of the Municipal Powers Act (CQLR, c. C-47.1), the Town of Kirkland may adopt by-laws concerning nuisances;
- WHEREAS pursuant to section 356 of the Cities and Towns Act (CQLR, c. C-19), notice of motion of this by-law was given and a draft of this by-law was filed at the regular sitting of the Municipal Council held on May 2, 2022;
- WHEREAS copies of this by-law were made available to the public;
- WHEREAS the Preamble forms an integral part of this by-law;

**THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:**

**ARTICLE 1 NUISANCE**

Chapter III of the by-law is amended by the modification of paragraph j) and the addition of paragraph o) at Article 3 so that it reads as follows:

- “3 Constitutes a nuisance the presence on a property or outside of a building of one of the following:
- j) graffiti or any kind of writing containing hate speech;
  - [...]
  - o) a pallet of wood or plastic, construction or excavation materials, tires, rims or other mechanical parts or an accumulation of garden items.”

**ARTICLE 2 NUISANCE PUBLIC DOMAINE**

Chapter V of the by-law is amended by the addition of paragraph r) at Article 11 so that it reads as follows:

- “3 The following acts constitute a nuisance:
- [...]
  - r) making or writing, on the public domain, in any manner whatsoever, hate speech;

**ARTICLE 3 COMING INTO FORCE**

This by-law shall come into force in accordance with the law.
