**BY-LAW ESTABLISHING A FUND DEDICATED TO THE
EXPENSES RELATED TO HOLDING A MUNICIPAL
ELECTION**

ADOPTION PROCEDURE

WHEREAS pursuant to sections 278.1 and 278.1 of the *Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities* (CQLR Chapter E-2.2), every municipality shall establish a fund dedicated to the financing of expenses related to holding an election which shall be made up of the sums allocated to it annually and of the interest earned on those sums;

WHEREAS pursuant to section 356 of the *Cities and Towns Act* (CQLR, c. C-19), notice of motion of this by-law was given and a draft of this by-law was filed at the regular sitting of the Municipal Council held on February 6, 2023;

WHEREAS copy of this by-law was made available to the public;

WHEREAS the Preamble forms an integral part of this by-law;

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL ORDERS AND DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1

In accordance with the *Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities* (CQLR chapter E-2.2), a fund is established by this by-law to finance the expenses related to holding an election.

ARTICLE 2

The total amount of this fund is established at \$160,000 and is made up of the sums allocated to it annually and of the interests earned on those sums.

To this end, an amount from the general fund shall be paid into the fund each year.

ARTICLE 3

If the fund is used to finance a by-election, the council must, before the next general election is held, provide for the reimbursement of the sums used.

ARTICLE 4

The present by-law comes into force according to law.
